## NOTICE OF ADVICE OF RIGHT TO COUNSEL FOR ALL JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS TO THE PERSON CHARGED:

- 1. This paper charges you with committing a crime.
- 2. If you have been arrested and remain in custody, you have the right to have a judicial officer decide whether you should be released from jail until your trial.
- 3. If you have been served with a citation or summons directing you to appear before a judicial officer for a preliminary inquiry at a date and time designated or within five days of service if no time is designated, a judicial officer will advise you of your rights, the charges against you, and penalties. The preliminary inquiry will be cancelled if a lawyer has entered an appearance to represent you.
- 4. You have the right to have a lawyer
- 5. A lawyer can be helpful to you by:
  - A. explaining the charges in this paper;
  - B. telling you the possible penalties;
  - C. explaining any potential collateral consequences of a conviction, including immigration consequences;
  - D. helping you at trial
  - E. helping you protect your constitutional rights; and
  - F. helping you to get a fair penalty if convicted.
- 6. Even if you plan to plead guilty, a lawyer can be helpful.
- 7. If you are eligible, the Public Defender or a court-appointed attorney will represent you at any initial appearance before a judicial officer and at any proceeding under Rule 4-216.1 to review an order of a District Court commissioner regarding pretrial release. If you want a lawyer for any further proceeding, including trial, but do not have the money to hire one, the Public Defender may provide a lawyer for you. The court clerk will tell you how to contact the Public Defender.
- If you want a lawyer but you cannot get one and the Public Defender will not provide one for you, contact the court clerk as soon as possible.
- DO NOT WAIT UNTIL YOUR TRIAL DATE TO GET A LAWYER. If you do not have a lawyer before the
  trial date, you may have to go to trial without one.

#### STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

ARREST ON TRAFFIC/NATURAL RESOURCES/MASS TRANSIT CITATIONS/CRIMINAL CHARGES/MUNICIPAL ORDINANCES/PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS

I then exited my marked agency-issued patrol vehicle and made a passenger-side approach. Upon arrival at the Tacoma passenger side window, I contacted the driver, later identified as Trent Allen HALL.

While contacting HALL, I observed a plastic bag that appeared to be torn off a larger plastic bag and tied into a knot. Through my training knowledge and experiences with the Calvert County Sheriff's Office, I know that tied-off plastic bags are used to store, transport, and conceal controlled dangerous substances. When I asked HALL to hand me the plastic bag, HALL's hands began to shake. HALL reached for the plastic bag when HALL grabbed the bag. HALL then tore off a portion of the bag, threw it on his driver-side floorboard, and handed me the empty portion. I then asked HALL to retrieve the bag he had thrown on the floor, and HALL did. Hall placed a small portion of a plastic bag on the passenger side seat, which I observed contained a white powdery substance.

I then asked HALL to exit the vehicle, and HALL was detained until other Sheriff's Office units arrived.

A search of the vehicle revealed the following:

- A plastic bag containing white powder (cocaine).
- 3 cut straws containing white powder residue located in the cup holder.

A search of HALLS person revealed the following:
Black metal container attached to keys containing white powder residue in front left pocket.
Through my training knowledge and experiences with the Calvert County sheriff's office, I know that cut straws are used to inhale controlled dangerous substances through the nasal cavity. I know that plastic bags and small metal containers are used to store, transport, and conceal controlled dangerous substances.
HALL was read his Miranda rights and stated that the white powdery substance was cocaine.
Cocaine is a Scheduled II controlled dangerous substance.
HALL was then transported to the Calvert County Detention Center.

#### STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Hall is being charged with CDS: possess- not cannabis and CDS: poss paraphernalia. HALL was also issued a warring for 75 in 55 mph zone.

I seized the suspected narcotics and sent it to the Maryland State Police Lab for testing. SDP-54251.

All the above-mentioned events were based on my training at the Southern Maryland Criminal Justice Academy in the area of controlled dangerous substance detection/ interdiction, Standardized Field Sobriety Testing and numerous arrests for individuals regarding controlled dangerous substances and DUI's as a Deputy with the Calvert County Sheriff's Office. As well additional training from: Intro to Patrol Drug Investigation, interview and interrogation, Drug Identification, Criminal Street Gangs, Police intelligence, Overview and Addiction & Connection to Treatment, Investigating overdose homicide, intro to highway rural drug investigation, Surveillance operations overview, Illicit internet drug sales, Over view of drug trafficking facilitators, Introduction to Clandestine Laboratory Investigations, Introduction to narcotics trafficking, Introduction to Drug Trafficking Funding Terrorism, Desert Snow Narcotics & Terrorist Interdiction Tactical Medical (Law Enforcement) and ARIDE.
